help for parents and teachers how does a worldview become a way of life this question is at the heart of scholar steven garber's book fabric of faithfulness and it shaped the recent lives of commitment grant that whitworth university received from the murdock charitable trust garber found that people who were identified by others as living with integrity between their beliefs and actions often had had a number of similar life experiences they developed a worldview that was sufficient for the questions or crises of the next 20 years they had parents or other mentors who helped them practice behaviors that matched their worldview they had first hand knowledge of the struggles of those with less in our society because they engaged in service of some sort they found friends who shared their worldview and the practices that went with it with garber's permission gloria goris stronks former calvin college education professor and julia stronks whitworth political science professor built on the
